



CMDS Uniform Policy Beginning August 2009

Lands' End school ID for CMDS **900054255**
Parker Uniforms school ID for CMDS **ME067074**

Students in Grades Senior Kindergarten-6 are to wear clothing that is included in the Christ Methodist Day School Uniform Policy.

Parker School Uniforms and Lands' End School Uniforms are the only vendors. Each vendor has been given our approved list.

GIRLS:

Tops for Girls

- Required crested RED shirt (from either vendor) which is to be worn on fieldtrips and on Thursdays with Khaki bottoms (shorts, skorts, skirts, pants)
- Tops (polos, turtlenecks, broadcloth, over blouse, middy blouse with tie, Peter Pan blouse) – Light Blue (also called chambray blue), White and Red - **ALL WITH CHRIST METHODIST CREST LOGO (pictured above)**
- Top – for jumpers can include white peter pan blouse without monogram

Bottoms for Girls

(Girls' short, skort, and skirt length should be no shorter than 4 inches above the back of the knee.)

- Khaki bottoms – pants, shorts, skirts or skorts from either vendor
- Parker CMDS plaid bottoms - skirts or culotte skorts
- Jumpers - Khaki with CMDS crest logo from either vendor or Parker Christ Methodist Plaid (no crest)

Miscellaneous for Girls

- Black or navy leggings from Parker or Land's End (Plain with no decoration)
- Girls may wear tights or knee socks (solid red, white, or navy blue only)
- Regular length socks should be white.

BOYS:

Tops for Boys

- Required crested RED shirt (from either vendor) which is to be worn on fieldtrips and on Thursdays with Khaki bottoms (shorts, pants)
- Tops (polos, turtlenecks, broadcloth) – Light Blue (also called chambray blue), White and Red - **ALL WITH CHRIST METHODIST CREST LOGO (pictured above)**

Bottoms for Boys

- Khaki bottoms – uniform pants **or** shorts from either vendor

Christ Methodist Day School Dress Code (Continued)

In addition, the following regulations apply to Grades K - 6:

1. Shirrtails must be tucked in. (The exception is the girls' over-blouse with squared off bottom.)
2. Belts must be worn with pants or shorts with belt loops.
3. Belts must be black, brown or the CMDS logo belt from the Parent's Association.
4. Socks must be worn and visible above the anklebone. Regular length socks should be white.
5. Tennis shoes are to be worn on physical education class days. (No slip-on tennis shoes)
6. No flip-flops, sandals, high heels, open toed shoes, boots or clogs are allowed.
7. No hats are allowed (except on "Hat Day" or outside hats for very cold weather days).
8. The wearing of make-up is not allowed.
9. Boys' hair must be worn above the collar. Boys may not wear earrings.
10. Extreme hairstyles are not allowed. Hair may not obstruct the eyes.
11. Girls' short, skort, and skirt length should be no shorter than 4 inches above the back of the knee. (Measure the hemline several times during the year. If in doubt, don't wear it.)
12. T-shirts worn under uniform shirts must be solid white. The sleeves may not be visible.
13. Unusual or new styles that occur will be addressed on an individual basis.
14. For inside wear; as part of the school uniform, students may wear:

Parker Uniform

- navy or red fleece jacket with logo
- navy or red sweatshirt with logo

Land's End uniform

- red fleece jacket or vest with logo
- red sweatshirt with logo.

The other choices are a solid color red or white sweater or sweater vest with logo from either vendor.

Sweatshirts should be worn with a collared garment underneath.

For outside wear, students may wear any appropriate coat, sweater, or sweatshirt

Consequences for being out of uniform include use of the conduct system and contact with parents. Students are expected to arrive at school in compliance with all aspects of the dress code.

**T-shirt days, crested shirt days, sweatshirt days, or jean days will remain in effect as scheduled.
