




SUMMER@CMDS FAQ



WHAT IS SUMMER@CMDS?

Summer@CMDS is Christ Methodist Day School's summer day camp program where your child can have a summer full of fun and games! Our mission is to provide students with a Christ-centered, safe, supportive, and entertaining environment! We offer fun-filled activities for physical involvement, social interaction, educational opportunities, personal growth, and creativity. Campers will be divided into groups by age, with activities appropriate to each group's interests, abilities, and needs.

WHEN CAN I REGISTER?

Registration is available online beginning Monday, February 12, <u>www.tinyurl.com/cmdsultracamp</u>. Registration is due Friday, April 21. After April 21, a late registration fee of \$80 per child will be applied.

WHAT DOES SUMMER@CMDS Offer?

- Day Camp, Three Days (7:45 a.m.-5:30 p.m.):
 \$220/week (Limited Space)
- Day Camp, Five Days (7:45 a.m.-5:30 p.m.):
 \$260/week
- Joining Before or After Enrichment Camp: \$155/week
- Joining Before or After Sports Camp: Prices may vary depending on the camp times.
- Enrichment Camps: Varied pricing and times. See individual camp descriptions.

WHAT WILL MY CHILD BE DOING?

Each week, children will explore different themes with movement, arts and crafts, music, water play, sports, games, and story-time. There is always plenty of time to make new friends and play with old friends.

WHO CAN COME?

Our day camp is open to the entire Memphis community, boys and girls, ages rising PK to rising 7th grade. Rising PK students must be 3 by June 1, 2024: All rising PK students must be potty trained to attend Summer@CMDS day camp and enrichment camps.

WHAT SHOULD WE BRING?

It is important your child brings a change of clothes each day because they will engage in water activities every day! What is summer fun without water? They will also need a towel, a packed lunch that does not need to be heated or refrigerated and a morning and afternoon snack.

TO REGISTER FOR SUMMER CAMP OR ENRICHMENT CAMPS AT CMDS, FOLLOW THE STEPS BELOW:

IF YOU ALREADY HAVE AN ULTRACAMP ACCOUNT THROUGH CMDS:

- 1. Log onto tinyurl.com/cmdsultracamp
- 2. Click "Make a Reservation."
- 3. Click on child's name. BE SURE TO ENTER THE RISING GRADE LEVEL THEY WILL BE ENTERING IN FALL 2024
- 4. Select the care you need for your child.
- 5. Click register at the bottom right side of the screen.
- 6. Confirm child's information.
- 7. If you have another child, select "Add additional reservations" and select the next child's name to repeat steps 3-6.
- 8. When you proceed to check out, you will see your full total. Click proceed to payment. (By clicking this, you are NOT paying in full.)
- 9. Here, you will choose the Summer@CMDS payment option.

IF YOU ARE NEW TO ULTRACAMP THROUGH CMDS:

- 2. Create an account by filling out the primary contact information.
- 3. Click "Make a Reservation."

 Click "Add a Person to my Account" to add your child. BE SURE TO ENTER THE RISING GRADE LEVEL THEY WILL BE ENTERING IN FALL 2024
 Confirm grade level.

- 6. Select the care you need for your child.
- 7. Click register at the bottom right side of the screen.
- 8. Fill out child's information.



SUMMER@CMDS Camp Policies and Procedures



HOURS OF OPERATION

Summer@CMDS is open from 7:45 a.m. until 5:30 p.m., Monday - Friday.

REGISTRATION

Before a student may attend Summer@CMDS, on a 5-day or 3-day basis, online registration and a \$60 non-refundable registration fee are required. Once registered, you will not be able to downsize your reservation from 5-day to 3-day or 3-day to drop in. You are only able to switch your reservation from 3-day to 5-day.

LATE PICK-UP FEES

Parents will be charged a late fee of \$25 for any pickup after 5:30 p.m. At 5:40 p.m., parents will be charged an *additional* \$5 per minute.

CANCELLATION

The \$60 registration fee is non-refundable. You have 5 business days to change or cancel your registration without penalty of owing for the camp week. If you cancel after the 5 business days prior, you will still owe for the cost of the camp week.

PHOTO RELEASE

By registering for Summer@CMDS, you agree to allow CMDS to publish photos, videos, artwork, and any other materials in both online and printed communication, unless you notify the Summer@CMDS Executive Director, Amanda Bardos, in writing if otherwise.

DISCIPLINE POLICY

Summer@CMDS reserves the right to dismiss from the program any student whose behavior poses a discipline problem. It is the director's discretion to determine dismissal from the program. No refunds will be issued for students who are asked to withdraw.

BILLING AND PAYMENTS

Participants are billed for all care on the first Monday of camp. Payments are only made through the Summer@CMDS online payment system, UltraCamp. Registration for the program and/or enrichment classes is not accepted without the appropriate payment. Delinquent payments will be charged a late fee.

Camp Policies and Procedures Continued...



ENRICHMENT CLASSES

Registration: Participants can register and pay for enrichment classes online. Many classes fill up, so we encourage you to enroll early to ensure a space. We have waiting lists for full classes. We do our best to get everyone off the waiting lists before enrichment camps begin. It is very important to get on a waiting list for full camps. Classes with insufficient enrollment are subject to cancellation with a full refund. There is no registration fee if you only register your child for enrichment classes (without day camp).

Full refunds for Enrichment Classes are available for withdrawals five business days before the camp begins. Except in those cases of illness or emergency reported to the Summer@CMDS office before the start of an activity, refunds will not be given once the activity begins. No refunds will be issued for children who choose not to attend.

LATE PICK-UP FEES

For the safety and security of our campers, Enrichment-only children left on campus after an Enrichment camp has ended will be escorted to the Summer@CMDS Day Camp. Parents will be charged \$60, which is the daily drop-in rate for Day Camp.

PICK UP AUTHORIZATION

Only authorized adults designated in the child's UltraCamp account will be permitted to pick up children from Summer@CMDS. If someone not listed on the child's UltraCamp account is scheduled to pick up, the director of Summer@CMDS must be notified in advance of the change. The parent or authorized adult to whom the child is being released will need to text the Summer@CMDS number and/or show proof of identification.

JUNE 10-14 VBS




JULY 22–26 That's <mark>a w</mark>rap

D IS FOR DINO DIG CREATIVE EDUCATION JUNE 17-21 PK-SK 9:30-11:30AM \$210





CMDS students have the option to schedule lessons within the school day if a mutually agreed upon time can be determined by the MMMA teacher, parents and CMDS teacher.

• MMMA also offers Rock 3:16, a one-hour class consisting of three to six students in complementary instruments.
